1. APPROVAL OF AGENDA AND CONFLICT OF INTEREST

5. QUALITY ASSURANCE PROCEDURES

5.1 <u>Approval of Draft Quality Assurance Procedures: Farm Advisory Services Ltd</u>

Following discussion, the Committee noted the recommendation of the QQI executive (A11/5.1) based on the recommendation of the Quality and Capacity Evaluation Panel report (A11/5.2). The Committee drew attention to an amendment required in Part 7 of the Report to the numbering referencing Part 6 – Conditions. The Committee approved the draft Quality Assurance procedures of Farm Advisory Services Ltd. However, the Committee noted that the Panel had referenced Data Protection requirements and requested that QQI draw this to the attention of the Provider and to future evaluation panels.

Farm Advisory Services Ltd is approved to progress to Stage 2 of the access to initial programme validation process.

6.1 <u>Requests for QQI to undertake Non-Statutory Reviews of Higher Education</u>
