# 6.3 Request for Modification of Validated Programmes

## 6.3.1 Carlow College, St Patrick's

The Committee NOTED the documentation circulated. Carlow College requested the inclusion of a new 5 ECTs elective 'Theology of Social Justice and Applied Ethics' module to the following three validated programmes:

6.3.1.1 PG23972, Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Social, Political and Community Studies, Level 8, Major Award, 240 Credits

PG23978, Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Arts and Humanities, Level 8, Major Award, 240 Credits

PG23980, Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in Applied Social Studies (Professional Social Care), Level 8, Major Award, 60 Credits

This interdisciplinary module was developed to address two recommendations made by the expert panel who evaluated these programmes during their review and revalidation in July 2018.

The Committee APPROVED the inclusion of the new *Theology of Social Justice and Applied Ethics* elective module to the three validated programmes above.

The named provider may submit revised procedures for approval within a six-month period of notification of this decision.

### 9.6 Harvest Resources Ltd

DCM has accepted the findings of the report and has agreed to implement the advised improvements set out by the panel.

## 11.1 Change of Status of Legacy HET and FET Providers
