Traineeships, Specific skills training








National Sales Apprenticeship Programme

- Blended mode of delivery

- New to sales / highly experienced in sales




Profile of the Sales Apprenticeship learner (2)








 with prior experience





















- Allows learners to express their knowledge in a deeper manner


