

Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI)

Guidelines for Transitional Award Logos

On 6 November 2012, Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI) (www.qqi.ie) was established as a new integrated agency (replacing the Further Education and Training Awards Council, the Higher Education and Training Awards Council and the National Qualifications Authority of Ireland and incorporating the functions of IUQB). FETAC, HETAC and the NQAI are now dissolved.

Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI) will continue to make awards based on standards developed by the Further Education and Training Awards Council and the Higher Education and Training Awards Council while it develops its own award standards and processes. The purpose of this document is to give guidelines for the appropriate use of logos during this transitional period.

The logos used by the former awarding councils are now withdrawn and should not be used on any new printed materials.

Awards formerly made by FETAC and HETAC continue to be recognised, because they are on the National Framework of Qualifications (www.nfq.ie). If you are a provider delivering a programme leading to a FETAC or HETAC award, now made by QQI, under processes originally developed by the former awards councils, QQI will permit the use of logos and brands based on those of the former councils. This is a transitional arrangement while new brands are developed.

The corporate logo of Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI) should never be used by providers.

The revised transitional award logos are now the only versions of the logos to be used and guidelines issued by the Further Education and Training Awards Council and the Higher Education and Training Awards Council are now withdrawn and no longer apply.
