- types of programmes that are of interest and those programmes outside this remit;
- accreditation/approval criteria; programme infrastructure in HEIs including QA;
- placement in HEIs and links to professional recognition; accreditation; standards;
- student/practitioner and graduate engagement ;
- other areas not referred to above.
