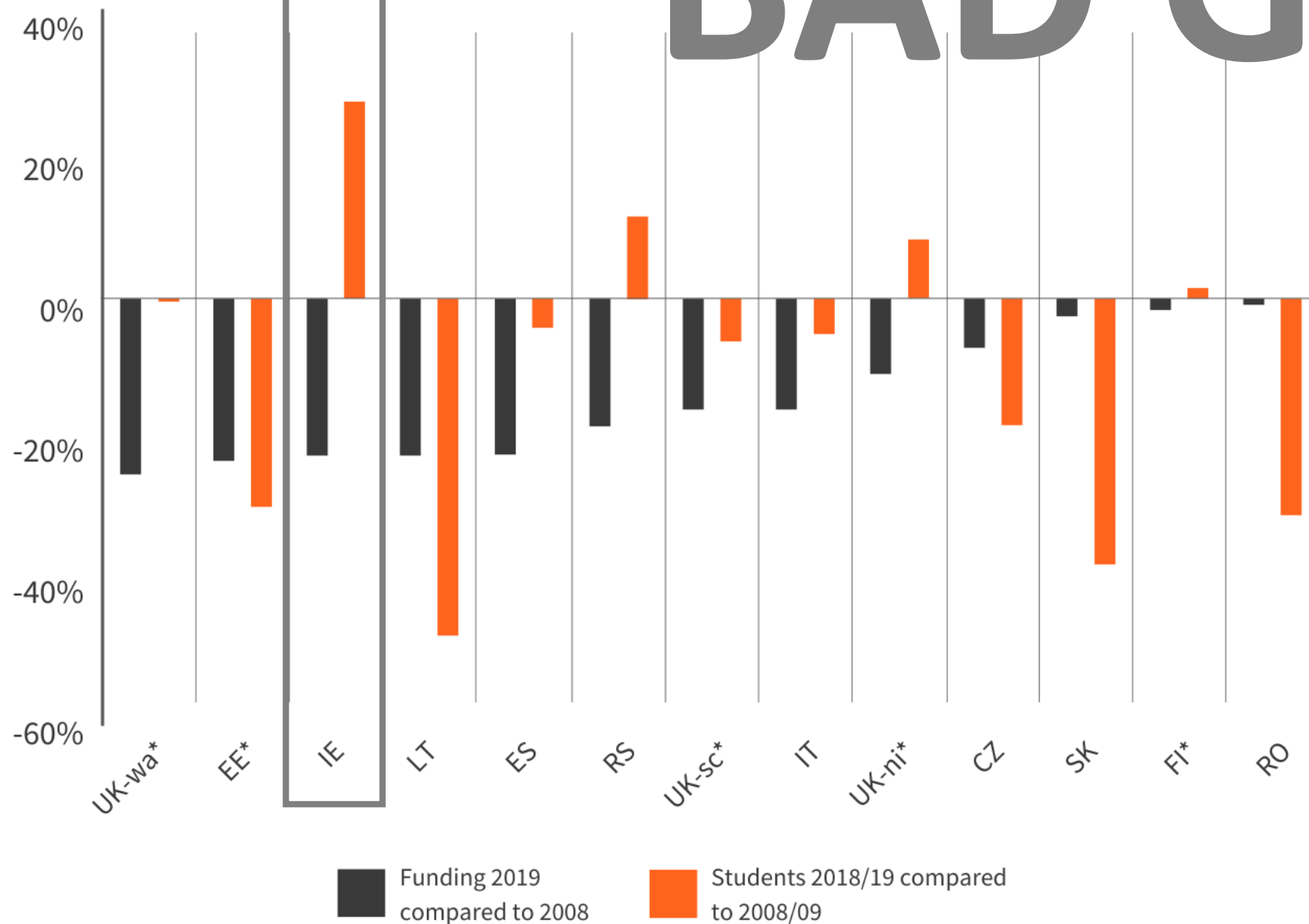

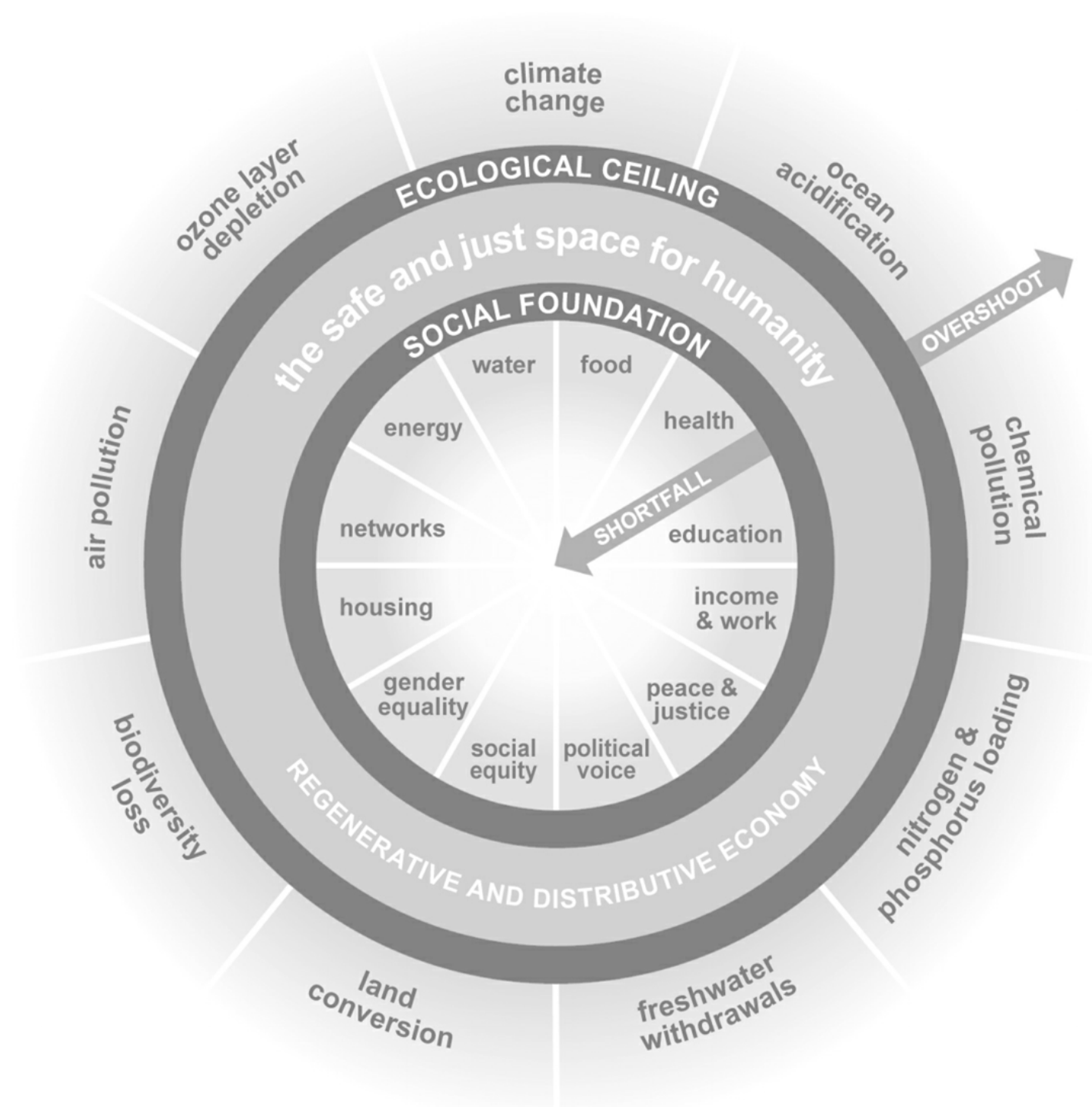

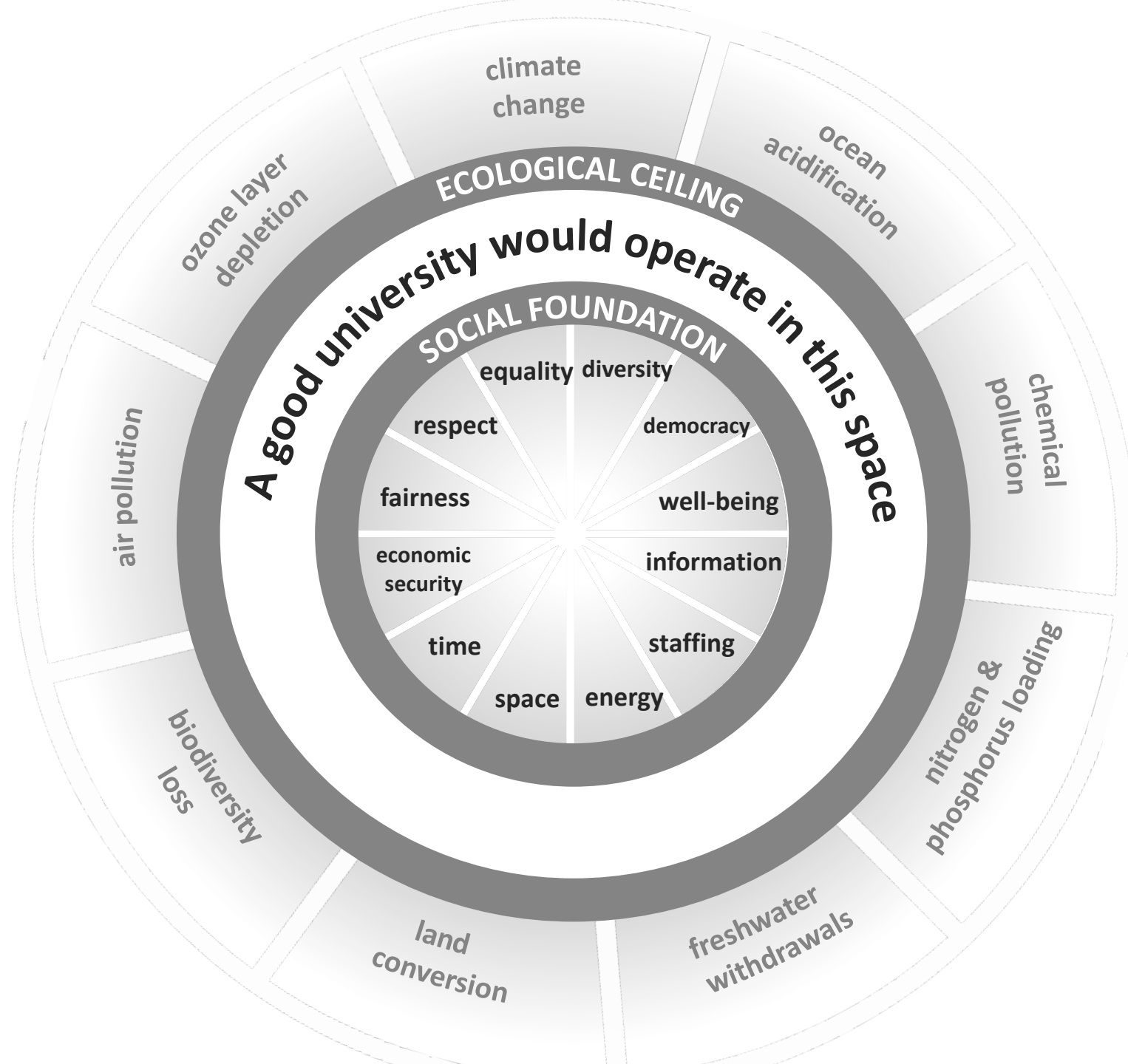
I propose that a good university is democratic, engaged, truthful, creative, and sustainable (pp. 198-199).

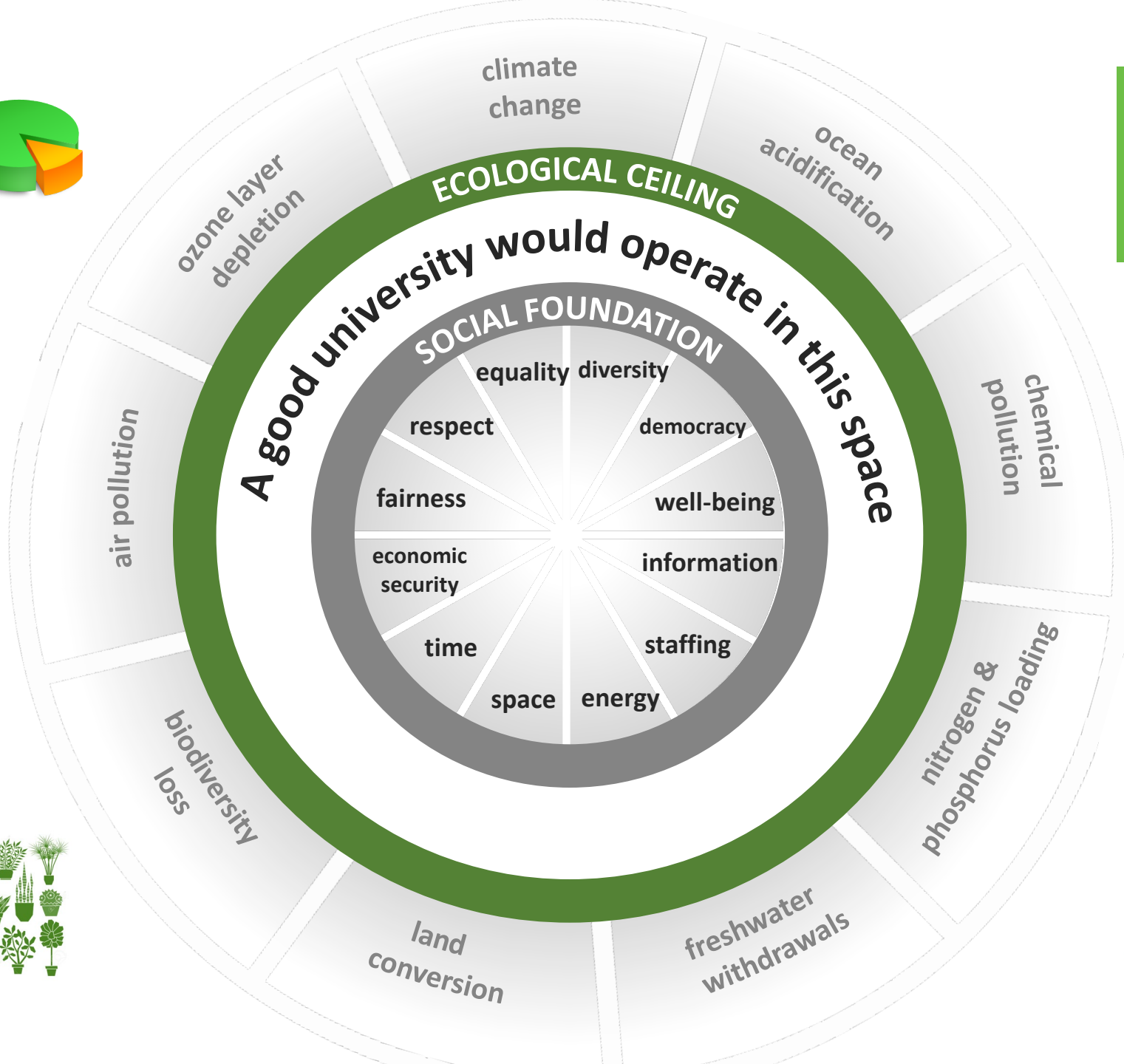


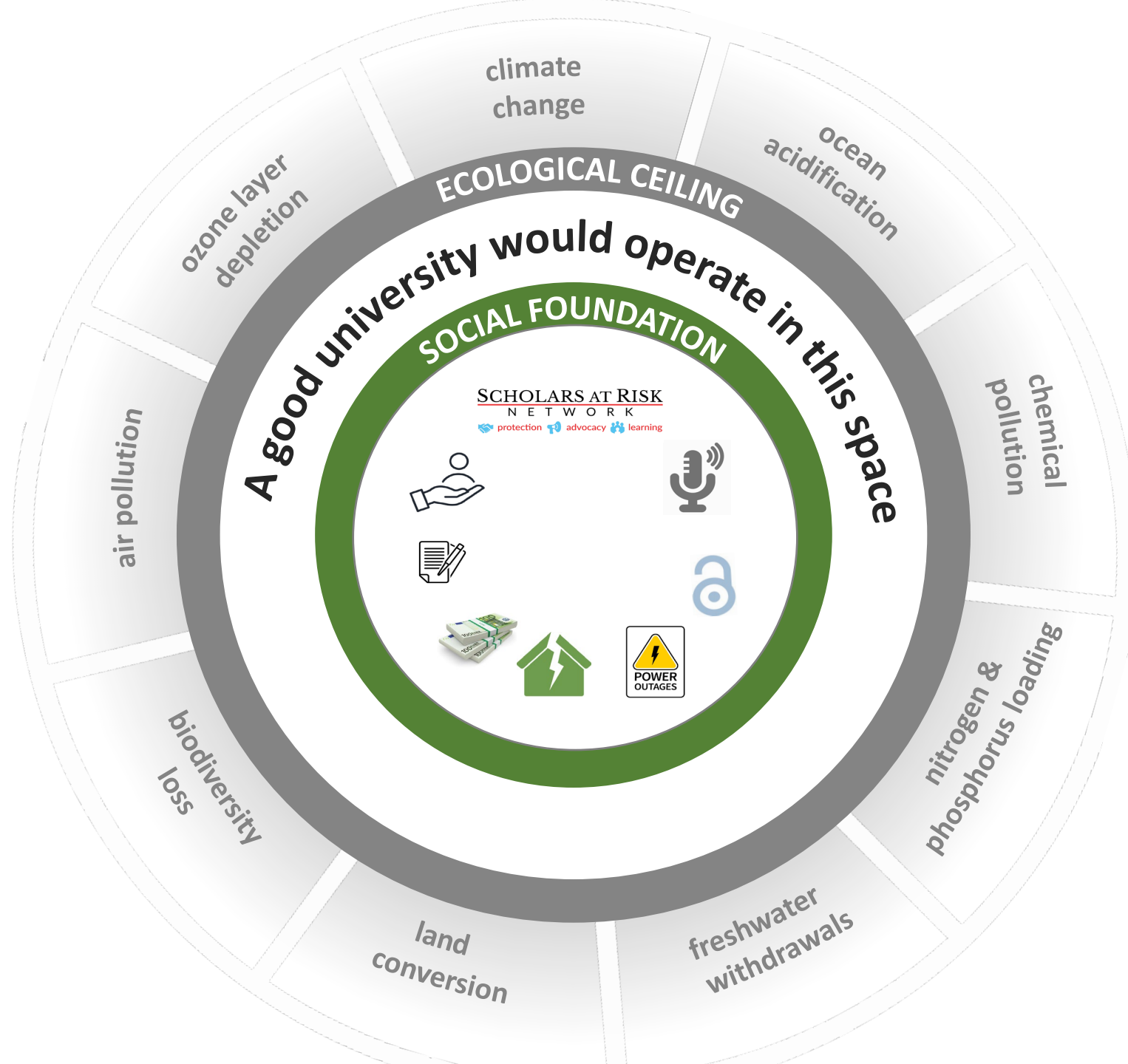
