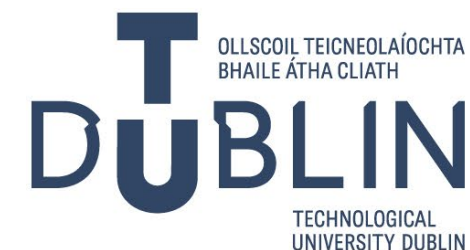

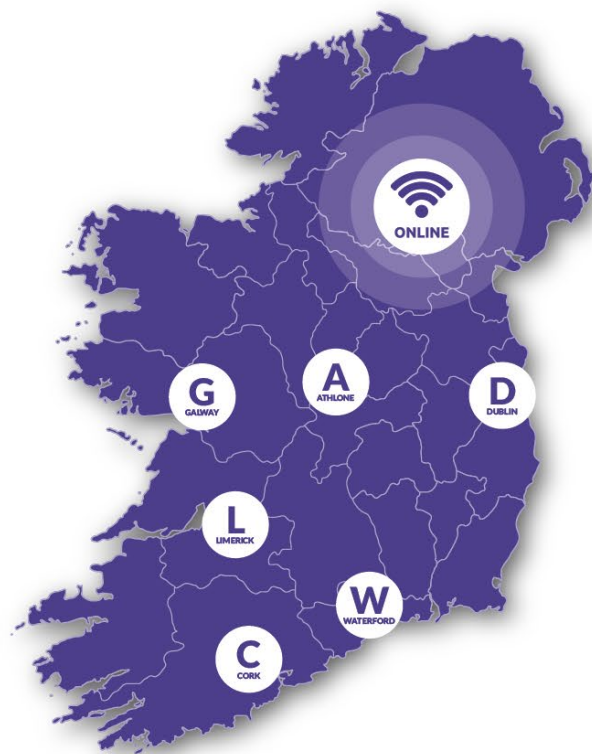


## Our Public / Private Partnership Model

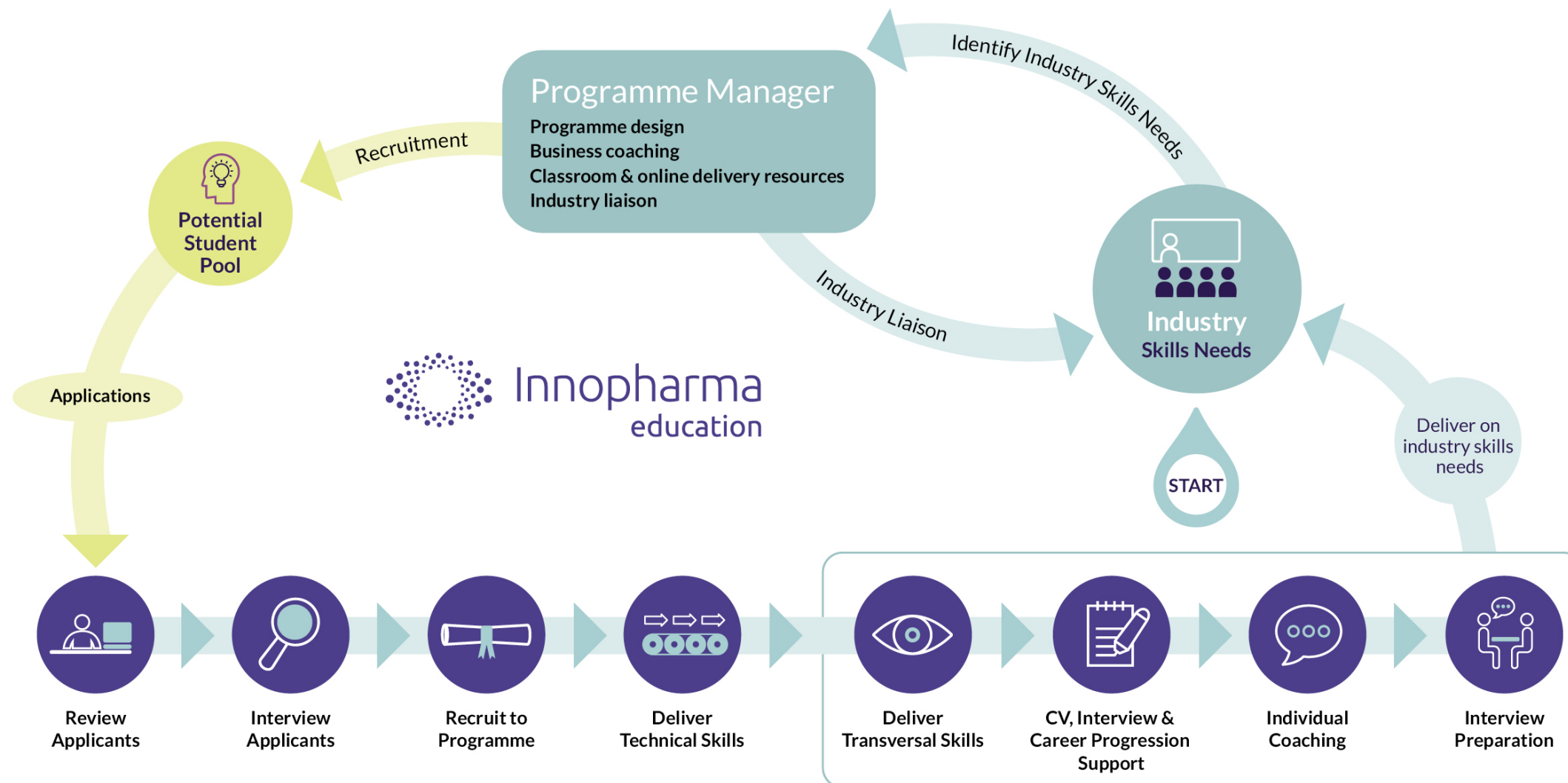


