

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

Module normal approval process via discipline/school


Approach

Process Flow Chart

- Over 20 ideas for new \bullet modules came in
- 16 of which followed \bullet through with the process
- 8 were approved (with 2 maybes)
- 5 new modules are going ahead for AY 2023/24







