At a Glance - QQI's Public Consultation on a Suite of Draft Broad Award Standards at NFQ Levels 1-4

Consultation Timeframe:

November 2022 – February 2023

Consultation Objectives:

- Gather general feedback on the appropriateness of each of twenty draft broad award standard
- Seek views on the Implementation Guidelines for implementing broad award standards at NFQ levels 1-4
- Explore flexibility and suitability of the new broad award standards in supporting the development of responsive programmes

Response to Consultation:

192 collective responses from individual institutions and representatives body including government agencies, professional recognition bodies, funders, social partners, teachers and FET providers.

Consultation Key Findings:

The innovation of the draft broad standards suite was welcomed and strongly supported by all stakeholders including education and training providers, ETBI and SOLAS.

- Proof all broad award standards and the accompanying Implementation Guidelines for accessibility and plain English prior to publishing
- Following QQI internal governance, QQI will commence publishing the broad award standards along with comprehensive Guidelines for their implementation, in the last quarter of 2023.
