TUS – new technological university

Whole of Institution Team-Based Approach

Impact 5-10 years

TUS Second Shot – April 2023

Multi-annual - Iterations

Curative and preventative measures



Consultation Phase

- Voluntary Participation
- Meetings with over 200 internal stakeholders over 90+ meetings
- 17 Different Central Functions
- 315 staff attended an online briefing
- Community of Purpose



TUS Second Shot

TUS-Wide Activities

- Centralised key information on website(s)
- Conduct in-person/online student briefings
- Slogan – Every Journey Starts with a Single Step – Take that Step!
- Sent a series of motivational text messages to students throughout the summer
- Signposted Students towards supports
 - Lecturers
 - Library
 - Togetherall
 - Tutors / LSU
 - Moodle
 - Study skills



TUS Second Shot Departmental Level Activity

TSS dashboard - Evidence Based Approach

3-2-1

Target Specific Cohorts

Ensuring all students had access to Moodle

Issue advisories regarding the repeats focusing on clarity of requirements

Increased collaboration with Tutors/LSU

Big Focus on Preventative Measures – “NTUTORR - A Focus on Retention” Series



Results after Two Iterations

Results and Report – Formal QA process

First Iteration

Autumn Repeat Success up 0.7%

5 Departmental Case studies >10%

Second Iteration

Autumn Repeat Success up 4.1%*

10 Departmental Case Studies >10%



Concluding Remarks

Multi-annual approach – NO QUICK FIX

First two iterations – far from perfect

Project is part of a bigger strategy

QA enhancement - iterations

Environment remains challenging
